观光景点:



釜山

- 海东龙宫寺 - 是位于韩国釜山机张郡的一座佛寺, 是韩国唯一一座建在海边的佛寺。佛寺于1376年由高丽恭愍王时期的王师懒翁大师所建
- 五六岛SKYWALK天空步道 - 以“行走在天上”之意将步道命名为“五六岛Skywalk”。Skywalk位于高达35公尺的悬崖上, 用铁制作的支柱加上24片玻璃板, 做成呈马蹄型, 全长15公尺的玻璃步道。
- APEC主题公园 - 第13届APEC高峰会的会场。拥有茂盛的冬柏树林及松树林环绕的自然景观, APEC过后则被活用为纪念馆和高级国际会议会场。整栋建筑外观是将韩国传统建筑“亭子”以现代式呈现, 屋顶则是将冬柏岛的棱线具体化而成, 内部装饰是以韩国传统文化为主, 展现出视觉上的效果。在以韩屋大厅为概念的阳台上, 还能一眼望尽五六岛, 广安大桥, 望月之丘等地, 不仅可以看到海云台的壮观美景, 也是一座融合自然美和现代美的高级国际会议场地。
- 甘川文化村 - 像童话小村般的缤纷色彩, 艺术风情, 更有着亲切可人的居民们, 被CNN报导称为“亚洲最艺术的村落”, 被誉为“釜山的圣托里尼”, 成为知名的文化景点。
- 龙头山公园 - 可一览釜山及内釜山港口的全景, 公园内竖立着朝鲜时代 (1392 - 1910年) 名将李舜臣将军的铜像和4.19纪念塔。

庆州

- 国立庆州博物馆 - 位于大韩民国庆尚北道原新罗的国都庆州市。国立庆州博物馆毗邻庆州历史遗迹地区的新罗皇室墓葬群, 瞻星台, 庆州月城主要展示收藏新罗文物, 年均参观人数在世界艺术博物馆中排名43。
- 佛国寺 - 1995年被联合国教科文组织指定为世界文化遗产, 佛国寺被誉为韩国最精美佛寺, 是迄今香火始终不断的为数不多的寺刹之一。寺内的多宝塔和释迦塔作为韩国最有代表性的古代塔建筑, 1962年被指定为国宝。
- 瞻星台 - 是由362个石块堆砌而成, 亚洲最早的天文台, 是新罗古老文化的象征。
- 石窟庵 - 它是一座以花岗岩建成的人工石窟寺院被联合国教科文组织指定为世界文化遗产。据说石窟庵与佛国寺同样建立于高丽时期。

首尔

- 南山公园之爱情锁墙 - 韩国代表性的爱情景点。
- 景福宫 - 是李朝 (1392~1910年) 时期首尔的五大宫之一, 也是李氏王朝的正宫, 具有500年历史。景福宫是李朝的始祖——太祖李成桂 (1392~1398年在位) 于1395年将原来高丽的首都迁移时建造的新王朝的宫殿。

雪岳山

- 雪岳山国家公园 - 游览新兴寺青铜坐佛像, 称为统一大佛, 历经11年完成, 是韩国最大的青铜佛像。

BUSAN

- **Yonggung Temple** - was first built in 1376 by the great Buddhist teacher known as Naong during the Goryeo Dynasty.
- **Oryukdo Skywalk** - was built on Seungdumal, a border between the East and South Sea. The Korean name translates to "walking in the sky", or so it's meant to feel like. This Horse Shoe - shaped bridge is set up against a 35m coastal cliff. With the entire bridge made of glass, you can watch the waves hit against the cliffs from under you.
- **APEC House** - has been used as a memorial hall and a prestigious international conference hall since the APEC summit meeting. Nurimaru, a 3-story building, is a modernist expression of "jeongja," a pavilion in traditional Korean architectural style. Its roof shape symbolizes the ridge line of Dongbaekseom Island. Its interior design is a visual display of Korea's creative traditional culture.
- **Gamcheon Culture Village** - "Korea's Santorini." "Korea's Machu Picchu." "Lego Village." These are the many nicknames the Busan neighborhood of Gamcheon 2-dong Village—has earned over the years.
- **Yongdusan park** - is considered a favorite resting place among the citizens of Busan. It is called Yongdusan because the shape of the mountain looks like the head of a dragon that climbs to land from sea. Yongdusan park has an area of about 69,000 m².

GYEONGJU

- **Gyeongju National Museum** - Gyeongju National Museum is steeped in tradition, representing Gyeongju, which was the capital city of the Silla Kingdom (BC57–AD935), the museum is where you can view the cultural history of Gyeongju district.
- **Bulguksa Temple** - The representative relic of Gyeongju and was designated as a World Cultural Asset by UNESCO in 1995. The beauty of the temple itself and the artistic touch of the stone relics are known throughout the world.
- **Cheomseongdae Observatory** - is a 7th century bottle-shaped stone structure admired by archaeologists worldwide.
- **Seokguram Grotto** - Designated as World Cultural Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1995, it is an artificial stone temple made of granite.

SEOUL

- **Namsan Park** - Love of Locks-Thousands of padlocks attached to the fence by romantic Seoulites symbolizing their undying affection.
- **Gyeongbok Palace** - Built in 1395, Gyeongbokgung Palace is also commonly referred to as the "Northern Palace" because it is the furthest north when compared to the neighboring palaces. Gyeongbokgung Palace is arguably the most beautiful and remains the grandest of all five palaces.

MT SORAK

- **Mt. Sorak National Park** - we will visit Sinhung Temple, which reflects the harmonization of nature and music.
